### From The Blessing When Putting On The Tallit

- ☞ The tallit connects us to the quantum level of our world. Modern-day physicists are only now revealing what the ancient Kabbalists knew to be true millennia ago: that our entire cosmos is interconnected as a whole on a deeper level of reality. The tallit's four corners connect us to the four corners of the universe. The power of the tallit helps us gain quantum control over our lives by spanning to the four corners of the universe, thereby controlling anything and everything that has an effect on us. Before we begin the blessing of the tallit, the Ari states that we must accept the precept "Love thy neighbor as thyself." We should make a sincere attempt to feel love for everyone in the world and care for their welfare as we do our own. Through this action, our prayer is connected to the prayers of all people on the planet.
- ☞ There are two parts to the Tallit, the garment and the tzitzit (fringes). The body is surrounded by the garment and the fringes hang off of it. This represents two aspects of the Creator, one that the Eternal is beyond our capacity to grasp which is represented by the garment that surrounds us. This represents only a tiny fraction of the Eternal, the tzitzit dangling off of the corners, that we can experience.
- ☞ The Eternal is the Tallit that surrounds us and also the Tzitzit which reaches down from the Upper Worlds for us to grab onto and kiss.
